

Reem Yassouf

Born in 1979 in Damascus, Syria, Reem Yassouf holds a Bachelor's degree in Fine Arts from Damascus, Syria (2000), and a Master's degree (DNSEP ART) from ESADHAR School in Rouen, France (2022).

As a visual artist, she explores various personal and collective themes through painting, installations, and diverse techniques. She employs raw materials with natural colors, often related to the body, space, light, and transparency, as well as memory across time and place.

Since 2015, she has lived and worked in France. She has participated in and helped organize numerous workshops and cultural events in both the Middle East and Europe. Additionally, she was a founding member of the independent festival "Khan Al Fnoun" from 2014 to 2016 in Jordan. Her work has been featured in various cultural publications, including a UNESCO book project and a summer book with the University of Oxford in 2014.

Her artworks have been acquired by UNESCO, the World Bank in Washington DC, the Arab World Institute in Paris, Cultural Narratives, the French Ministry of Europe and Foreign Affairs in Paris, the Atassi Foundation, and private collections.
